Participants becoming lost	Participants	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Boundaries to be identified during the briefing and time limit given. 2. Groups under the age of eleven to be accompanied by an adult. 3. If a group is more than thirty minutes overdue search party is to be sent. 4. A clear meeting point is established for returning or lost group members at beginning of session. 5. No less than 4 members in a group. 6. Establish procedures for members in the event of an injury at beginning of session. 	
Trip Hazards i.e. Hesley Wood is a natural wood, as with any woodland area uneven floor and woodland debris are present.	Participants	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Groups to be warned during briefing. 2. Groups to be advised to wear appropriate footwear. 3. Instructor to have first aid kit or be aware of where nearest one is. 	
High Winds/Storms	All involved	1.Group to be rounded back in and stop the session, as soon as.
