Hazards arising from the actions of group members i.e. overcrowding disorderly behaviour.	All involved	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Group leader must be present during sessions.</li> <li>If group member's behaviour becomes dangerous follow the EAP for disorderly behaviour or overcrowding as appropriate.</li> </ol>	
Trips, Slips and falls	Participants	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Equipment to be laid out in suitable flat grassed area.</li> <li>Warn the group to take care.</li> <li>First aid kit to be taken to session</li> </ol>	
Manual Handling	Participants Instructor	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Instructor to carry equipment carefully when setting out so as not to strain themselves.</li> <li>Be warned during briefing to lift with their legs not back.</li> </ol>	
Instructor, Instructor error	All involved	All instructors must pass in house training.

Maintaining Social Distancing	All	Group Leader to manage participants who are waiting for their turn. To use the 2 metre marking in waiting areas.	
Track and Trace	All	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Group to provide Hesley Wood with a list of participants in each activity group, to be retained for 21 days.</li><li>2. Group Leader to notify Hesley Wood if any participant becomes a confirmed Covid-19 case after event.</li></ol>
